



Julie Sullivan is Immediate Past Chair of Roundup River Ranch, an organization that provides free medically-supported camp programs to children with serious illnesses and their families. Roundup River Ranch is a member of the SeriousFun Children's Network, the largest family of medical camps and programs in the world, which was founded by Paul Newman.

Roundup River Ranch opened its camp in Gypsum, Colorado in 2011 and, as of 2019, has provided over 9,000 camper experiences, all free of charge.

Julie earned her BA at Boston College and her JD at Catholic University Law School.

Julie joined the Board of Directors at Roundup River Ranch in 2014 and has served as Vice-Chair, Chair, and currently is Immediate Past Chair. Julie is the Chair of the Board Member Development and Governance Committee and is on the Human Resources, Executive, and Medical Advisory Committees. She also serves on the SeriousFun Children's Network Board as Roundup River Ranch's representative.

Julie has worked at Mudge Rose in New York City, Kirkland & Ellis in Chicago, and Warner Norcross & Judd in Grand Rapids. She has served as a member of the Foundation Board of the Rehabilitation Institute of Chicago, where Julie and her husband co-chaired the annual appeal. Julie has also served on her local school's foundation, community hospital board quality, and her town's Accessibility Committee.
